In order to prevent future incidents that would place students, faculty, and staff at risk, we suggest the following precautions:

1. Notify University personnel immediately if there are any circumstances in which there are suspicious persons or unusual circumstances.
2. Avoid walking in isolated and poorly illuminated areas of the campus.
3. Avoid parking outside of the campus area.
4. If you leave your car, ensure that the car is locked and the motor turned off.
5. When walking towards the car make sure to take keys in hand.
6. Do not walk by oneself in isolated areas such as bathrooms, stairs or parking lots.
7. Park car in areas which are well illuminated and heavily populated.
8. Avoid wearing expensive jewelry and other items that would generate attention.
9. Do not leave valuable objects within exposed areas of the car, or wait to arrive at destination to hide these objects in the trunk.
10. Close and secure car.
