To prevent any incidents that would place students, faculty and staff at a risk, we suggest the following precautions:

5. When walking towards the car, make sure to take the keys in your hands.
6. Do not walk by oneself in isolated areas such as bathrooms, stairs and parking lots.
7. Park your car in areas which are well illuminated and heavily populated.
8. Avoid wearing expensive jewelry and other items that would attract the attention.
9. Do not leave valuable objects within exposed areas of the car, or wait to arrive at your destination to hide these objects in the trunk.
